## Inner City Bypass Upgrade – Weekend lane closures

**The ICB upgrade is an initiative of Brisbane City Council and is being delivered by Transurban Queensland.**

Brisbane City Council and Transurban Queensland wish to advise of temporary traffic changes on the Inner City Bypass (ICB) over five consecutive weekends from **Friday 12 January to Monday 12 February 2018**, weather permitting.

For the safety of workers and motorists, during these weekends the following traffic changes will be in place:

- the ICB eastbound will be reduced to one lane between Legacy Way and the Herston Road exit from 7pm to 5am during January and 8pm to 5am during February.
- the Herston Road exit will be closed from 7pm to 5am during January and 8pm to 5am during February. A signed detour will be in place via Lutwyche Road and Bowen Bridge Road.
- the ICB eastbound will be reduced to two lanes between Legacy Way and the Herston Road exit from 5am to 7pm during January and 8pm to 5am during February.

### What to expect during construction:

- ICB eastbound lane closures and Herston Road off-ramp closure
- A signed detour will be in place via Lutwyche Road and Bowen Bridge Road during the ramp closure (refer to map for detour)
- Traffic control and reduced speeds will be in place to ensure the safety of road users
- Increased noise and light from construction activity
- Increased activity around the work area including the presence of workers, vehicles and equipment.

In the case of adverse weather conditions or delays, this work will be postponed to the next available weekend. We appreciate your patience and understanding and will work to minimise any disruption to your travel as much as possible.

### About the Project:

Brisbane City Council and Transurban Queensland are widening the ICB between Legacy Way and the RNA tunnel to increase capacity and allow for future traffic demand and growth along the key corridor. The project will improve travel times and safety for all road users as well as improving connectivity to the wider road network.

The upgrade includes:

- widening the ICB westbound from three to four lanes between the westbound approach to the RNA tunnel and the Legacy Way portal
- widening the ICB eastbound from three to four lanes between the Legacy Way portal and Herston Road exit

- construction of a new westbound ramp to the ICB from Bowen Bridge Road, open to all vehicles and allowing buses to connect directly to the ICB from the Inner Northern Busway
- new bus priority measures at the Herston Road exit off the ICB, including a new dedicated bus priority lane.
