## INNER CITY BYPASS UPGRADE PROJECT

### Traffic changes – ICB westbound between RNA tunnel and Legacy Way portal

The Inner City Bypass (ICB) upgrade is an initiative of Brisbane City Council and is being delivered by Transurban Queensland. The upgrade will increase capacity, improve travel times and safety for all road users, and improve connectivity to the wider road network.

From early August, traffic changes and construction works will start on the ICB westbound between the Royal National Agricultural (RNA) tunnel and the Legacy Way portal (see map overleaf).

**The following changed traffic conditions will be implemented in early August and will be in place for up to 12 months:**

- the speed limit between the westbound approach to the RNA tunnel and the tunnel exit will be reduced to 50km/h
- the westbound approach to the RNA tunnel will be reduced to three lanes
- on approach to the westbound RNA tunnel, the AirportLink M7 and Clem7 lanes will merge into one, prior to entering the tunnel.
