ROADSIDE TOLLING UPGRADE PROJECT

Night works – Gateway Motorway southbound toll point at Kuraby

As part of Transurban Queensland's Roadside Tolling Upgrade project (RTU), construction works will be undertaken on the Gateway Motorway at Kuraby near the southbound toll point (see map).

The works will take place on Wednesday 19 July and Thursday 20 July 2017, between 7pm and 5am.

For the safety of workers and motorists, temporary five-minute closures of the Gateway Motorway at Kuraby will be intermittently required during the works. The closures will take place between 1am and 3am to allow motorists to continue to utilise the Gateway Motorway southbound throughout the planned construction works.

The works will be undertaken by our contractor Mcllwain Civil Engineering.

What to expect during construction:

- traffic control and lane closures on the Gateway Motorway southbound near the toll point at Kuraby, including reduced speed limits, to ensure the safety of motorists (refer to map for location)
- increased noise and light from construction activity
- increased activity around the work area including the presence of workers, vehicles and equipment
- vehicles and equipment with reverse beepers will be used to ensure the safety of workers on site.

In the case of adverse weather conditions or delays to the work, this work will be postponed to the next available shift.

All works will be scheduled to minimise impacts on the community and motorists – we thank you in advance for your patience during these works.

About the project:

The RTU project is part of Transurban Queensland's ongoing asset renewals program to maintain the high quality and efficiency of the **go via network**.

The project includes the construction of new tolling gantries to replace existing gantries, construction of new roadside safety barriers and the upgrading of tolling equipment along the network.

Construction of the project is scheduled to commence in April 2017 and be completed late 2018, weather permitting.
